

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PAUMA VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT APPROVAL OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FORMING A MULTI-PARTY GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY FOR THE SAN LUIS REY VALLEY GROUNDWATER BASIN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 10723(b) of the California Water Code and Section 6066 of the California Government Code that the Board of Directors of the Pauma Valley Community Services District (PVCSD) will hold a public hearing to consider approving a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the County of San Diego, Yuima Municipal Water District, and the Upper San Luis Rey Resource Conservation District to become a multi-party groundwater sustainability agency (GSA) for the San Luis Rey Valley Groundwater Basin (Bulletin 118, Basin No. 9-7.) The meeting of PVCSD to consider approving the MOU will take place on May 30, 2017 at 10:00 am., in the Boardroom of its headquarters, located at 33129 Cole Grade Road, Pauma Valley, California.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to hear comments from the public regarding PVCSD's proposed approval of the MOU.

At the end of the public hearing, the Board may approve, disapprove or modify the draft MOU.

The draft MOU and related documentation are on file with the Secretary to the Board of Directors of PVCSD and are available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the PVCSD at 33129 Cole Grade Road, Pauma Valley, California.
