FOR WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES
UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE



CONDITIONS: RPMWC anticipates that it may not be able to meet the demands of its customers during the remaining summer months and into the fall. All customers will be **required to achieve a twenty percent (20%) reduction** in water usage, on a monthly basis, measured against the average usage for the three years preceding this year. This reduction is intended to also comply with recently enacted California law that requires conservation.

REQUIREMENTS: RPMWC staff will provide each customer with their average 3-year historical usage for the current month beginning in August and continuing until further notice. RPMWC staff will monitor compliance with this mandatory reduction as well as the additional restrictions set forth immediately below.

1. There shall be no washing down of drive ways or hardscape, except when it is absolutely necessary to alleviate safety or health hazards.
2. There shall be no inefficient landscape irrigation, such as runoff, low head drainage, overspray, water flows onto non-targeted areas (such as adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, hardscapes, roadways or structures).
3. Irrigation of residential landscape may take place only between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. and of recreation fields only between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
4. Irrigation of golf courses, landscape and commercial nurseries, and commercial growers may take place at any time but only with drip type irrigation or water efficient rotators.
5. Any washing of vehicles, trucks, RVs, boat, trailers, aircraft, or the like shall be done using a bucket only - no hoses permitted.
6. No RPMWC supplied water shall be used to operate ornamental fountains, water features, or the like (other than swimming pools and ornamental ponds with aquatic life), nor for earthwork or road construction purposes, and RPMWC will not issue new construction meters.
7. Restaurants shall not serve water to customers unless specifically requested and then only by using disposable cups.

ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES: Warning notices shall be issued by RPMWC staff upon any issue of non-compliance with the Stage II restrictions. Subsequent to having received a Warning notice, a shareholder will be billed for all water used at **twice the then applicable Tier III prices** until the shareholder has been in demonstrated compliance for one calendar month. State of California regulations can impose a fine of up to \$500/day for non-compliance.
